

Link Route - East Devon Way to Whitford



Start location: East Devon Way - T-junction halfway between Colyton and Musbury (SY 260 947)

Difficulty: Easy - Can be very wet in winter

Walking time: 20 mins **Length:** 1km/just over a half mile

Route summary: This is an off-road link route from the East Devon Way to nearby village, Whitford

Directions - south to north

- 1 **Start at the T-junction on the East Devon Way** - Through the gate and follow the fingerpost > Field can be wet, but easy to work around the bad bits > Through gate at far end of field > Turn left > Over a stile in under the trees > Continue straight on to a gap in the hedge >
- 2 **Follow the path around the curve to gate** - > Carry on down the track - it emerges on the road near the Whitford Bridge >
- 2 **From here you can:**
 - » Turn left for Whitford
 - » Turn right and over the river to enter the layby with seat, parking and access to the riverside.

Link Route - Whitford to East Devon Way



Start location: Whitford Bridge, Whitford - (SY 262 954)

Difficulty: Easy - Can be very wet in winter

Walking time: 20 mins **Length:** 1km/just over a half mile

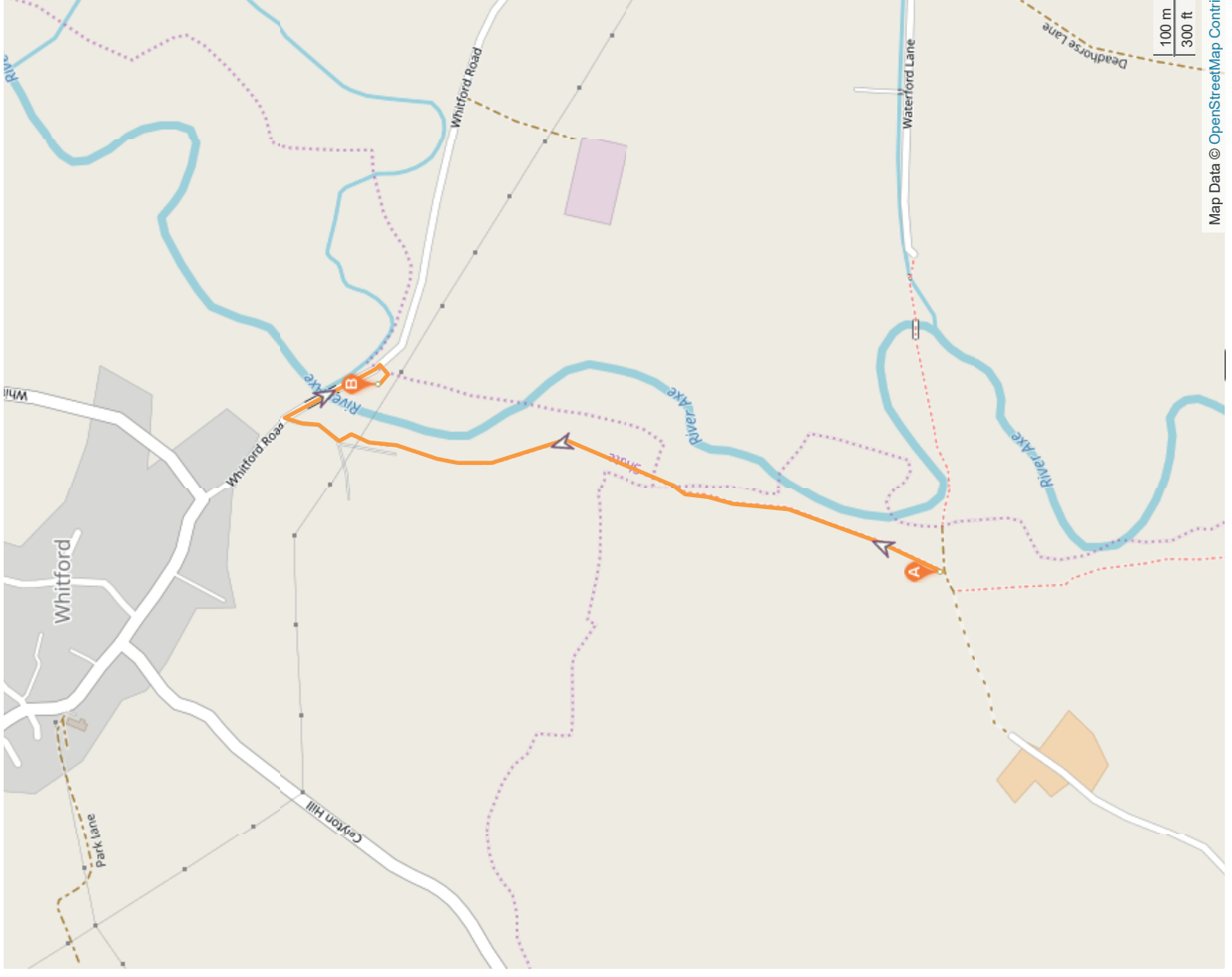
Route summary: This is an off-road link route from Whitford to the East Devon Way.

Directions - north to south

- 1 **Start in the car park by the Whitford bridge (bus route passes through here)** - Cross the bridge > Turn left after the bridge down a track > Follow the link waymarker down the track into field > Follow curve around the edge of field > Go through the gap in the hedge > Carry on straight across the field >
- 2 **Over the stile in the dip under the trees** - Proceed to the small gate ahead of you, to the right > Through the gate > Turn left and cross field to gate to: The T-junction with the East Devon Way.
- 2 **From here you can:**
 - » Turn left for Musbury, Musbury Castle and on to Lyme Regis
 - » Turn right and follow the East Devon Way to Colyton.

Amenities in Whitford: Accommodation and bus route.
